Place Ministries will be presenting this “Train the Trainer” Workshop. This workshop will assist in equipping church leaders in the area of volunteer ministry placement. In other words, as a church leader, you will understand how to implement a strategy that will help you place your volunteers in the right ministry.

The workshop will consist of 3 major components:
#1 Self Discovery: You will be trained to understand the 5 PLACE Assessments and how they are vital to the overall big picture in connecting God’s people to meaningful ministry.
#2 Connection Coaching: You will be equipped as a PLACE Connection Coach and receive the necessary training to train others to carry out this role.
#3 Ministry PLACEment: You will be challenged to create your own ministry assimilation plan and given the necessary elements to implement a successful ministry placement strategy.

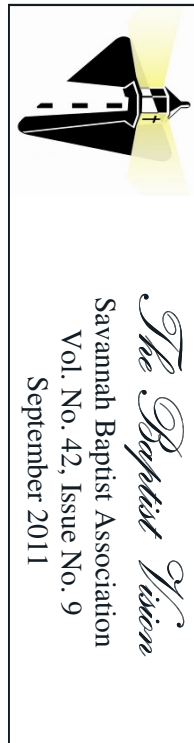
